# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Load the following URL in your web browser. Click on the link for the PSLDesk installer and follow the instructions below.

You may encounter the following when you first download the installer. Click on the More Info link and the Run Anyway button will appear.



Click on Run Anyway.




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

The PSLDesk installer screen will look like this image.


The installer will install 2 items,

- Adobe Air runtime
- PSLAgent application

When ready Click on the [Next] button to begin the install.




Click [I Agree] to accept Licence Agreement




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Unless otherwise instructed leave as per the defaults and click on the [Next] button




Accept the default location and click [Next]




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Click [Next] to continue




Click on the [OK] button to continue




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Click on the [I Agree] button to continue




Click the [Finish] button to continue




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Click on the [OK] button to continue




Click on the [Install] button to install PSLAgent




# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

Unless otherwise instructed accept the default settings and click on the [Continue] button




The installation has finished and you can click on the [Finish] button before continuing on to the PSLAgent screen for setup.



# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

The PSLDesk application will now open. It will look and work in the same manner as Console.


To log in you use your existing username and password.



# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

A one-off process will now run to synchronise the various modules with the PSLDesk application.

This process will not normally run when you log in unless there have been updates to modules.



# Installing PSLDesk-Beta

PSLDesk will now load all the modules you have access to. The modules operate in the same manner as they would in Console.

To exit PSLDesk you must log out before closing the window.
